

The Majesty Project: Artist Submissions Guidelines

Introduction to The Majesty Project

At *The Majesty Project*, our mission is to spread the majesty of God and Jesus Christ through original artwork in at-risk communities. We believe that art is a powerful way to reflect the beauty and grandeur of God's creation and to inspire hope, awe, and reverence in those who experience it. As part of this vision, we are calling on artists to submit their work for consideration, with a focus on creating large, beautiful, and majestic representational art that reflects God's creation.

Why We Emphasize Representational Art

The heart of *The Majesty Project* is to reflect God's majesty through art that celebrates His creation in a direct, visible, and tangible way. Representational art—the depiction of the world as it is, as created by God—reflects the order, beauty, and wonder that God has already established. By creating art that represents the world around us, we affirm that beauty and truth are not of our own making but are inherent in God's design.

In contrast, abstract art tends to prioritize personal expression and subjective vision, often reflecting the artist's inner world rather than the outer world created by God. While abstract art can have its place in other contexts, *The Majesty Project* focuses exclusively on representational art because we believe that it is a powerful means of worshiping and honoring God by reflecting His creation. We are seeking works that point beyond the artist and their self-expression, toward the Creator and His divine artistry.

Guidelines for Submissions

We are looking for large, beautiful, and majestic representational works of art that reflect the following principles:

1. Celebration of Creation

Your artwork should reflect the beauty and majesty of the natural world, whether through landscapes, portraits, wildlife, or other representations of creation. Focus on the awe-inspiring aspects of God's handiwork—preferably inspired by a bible verse or passage, which will be hung as a plaque beneath the artwork at its final installation.

2. Size and Impact

We are particularly interested in larger-scale works that will have a powerful, lasting visual impact when displayed in public spaces. The size of your piece should be appropriate for large wall installations that can engage a wide audience and invoke a sense of awe and reverence. (This preference is on a case-by-case basis, and may need to be adjusted for the display's availability purposes.)

3. Beauty and Majesty

The artwork should be visually compelling, with a focus on capturing the inherent beauty and majesty of the subject matter. We are seeking works that evoke a sense of wonder and elevate the spirit, reflecting the grandeur of God's creation in a way that is both artistically accomplished and deeply reverent.

4. Faithful Representation

Your art should faithfully depict the subject as it appears in nature, staying true to the essence

and reality of the forms you are portraying. We are not looking for highly abstract interpretations; rather, your work should honor the details and structure of the world as it was created by God. We do encourage embellishments – whether metallic, paint, marker, gold foil, etc. – to bring the artist’s interpretation of ‘majesty’ to life.

5. Worship Through Art

At its core, the art you submit should be an act of worship. We encourage artists to approach their work with a spirit of humility, recognizing that the true Creator is God, and the artist is merely reflecting His glory through their craft. Your work should inspire others to reflect on the divine, to see God's hand in the world around them, and to engage with His beauty.

Why Abstract Art is Not Accepted

While we value all forms of creative expression, *The Majesty Project* is focused on representational art because it points to God as the Creator rather than the artist. Abstract art emphasizes the artist’s subjective interpretation of reality, drawing attention to their emotions, intentions, or inner thoughts. In contrast, representational art directs the viewer's gaze outward, toward the inherent beauty and order of the world created by God. It is through this outward-focused art that we seek to glorify God, acknowledging that He is the true Artist and that beauty is found in His creation, not in human reinterpretation.

We believe that by choosing to focus on representational art, *The Majesty Project* can more directly engage with communities and inspire them to see the majesty of God through the lens of the natural world.

Submission Process

To submit your artwork to *The Majesty Project*, please ensure that your piece adheres to the above guidelines and submit the following:

1. **Artist Statement:** A brief explanation of your subject matter and technique, as well as how your work reflects the glory of God.
2. **High-Quality Images of Your Work:** Clear photographs or digital images that showcase the details and scale of your art.
3. **Dimensions of the Artwork:** Please specify the size and any relevant installation requirements.
4. **Portfolio:** A selection of past works (if applicable) that demonstrate your ability to create large-scale, representational art similar to what we are looking for.
