Submission Guidelines for Artists Donating to the Majesty Project

Welcome to the Majesty Project. Our mission is to glorify God through art that captures the beauty, majesty, and hope found in His creation. We are seeking contributions from artists whose works resonate with these themes and demonstrate both spiritual depth and artistic excellence.

Eligibility

- Artists must be born-again Christians actively attending a local church.
- Each contributor should be committed to reflecting Christian values in both life and art.
- We ask that you would take the time to participate in our 30-Day Artist Devotional available on our resources page

Guidelines for Submissions

We are (primarily) looking for large, beautiful, and majestic works of art that reflect the following principles:

1. Celebration of Creation

- Your artwork can showcase the beauty and majesty of the natural world through landscapes, portraits, wildlife, or other representations of creation, with creative freedom of interpretation, embellishment, or additions
- Pieces should preferably be inspired by a Bible verse or passage (even loosely), as Majesty Project will display a plaque presenting this scripture beneath the artwork at its final installation to point the viewers to the Bible.

2. Size and Impact

- We are interested primarily in larger-scale works that command attention and inspire awe in public spaces.
- Of course, there are exceptions when large spaces are unavailable, and certain installations will only allow smaller pieces.

3. **Beauty and Majesty**

• The artwork should be visually compelling, with a focus on capturing the grandeur of God in an artistically accomplished and reverent manner. The presentation, of course, is up to the artist's interpretation and design.

4. Faithful Representation

- Submitted art should, in some aspect, reflect the reality and essence of representational subject matter, honoring God's creation with individual creativity and unique insight without succumbing to highly abstract interpretations.
- We encourage embellishments to creatively express majesty, such as metallics or gold foil.

5. Worship Through Art

 Your submission should be an act of worship, crafted with humility to reflect God's glory and inspire others to see His beauty in the world around them. Artists should approach this opportunity with the heart of servanthood, rather than the intention of being seen or promoted. These privileges may accompany being represented by Majesty Project, but they should not be the goal.

Unacceptable Submissions

Majesty Project adheres to certain standards of Biblical goodness, truth, and beauty, and due to these, the following categories or aspects will not be accepted:

- Works that are entirely disconnected from truth, beauty, or biblical themes.
- Fully abstract works lacking any discernible meaning or reference.
- Works that **appear rushed, unrefined,** or otherwise misaligned with the Majesty Project's mission and aesthetic philosophy.
- Artwork sensationalizing and glorifying blood, brutality, or fear outside of Christian hope and gospel messaging.
- **Nudity, eroticism,** or sensual themes that distract from holiness.
- Symbols or themes tied to witchcraft, false gods, or mocking the sacred.

- Art that demeans others, uses profanity, or tears down rather than builds up.
- While lament and struggle have a place in Christian art, work that only dwells on darkness without pointing toward light, hope, or Christ will not be accepted.

Why Purely Abstract Art is Not Accepted

While all creative expressions are valued, The Majesty Project focuses on at least partially representational art to point to God as the Creator, directing viewers to the innate beauty of His creation, scriptures, and morality, and away from solely human interpretation. By emphasizing art with intentional subject matter, we aim to engage communities in witnessing God's majesty in a way the average viewer will understand.

Terms & Discretion

The Majesty Project **reserves full discretion to accept or decline any submission.** We appreciate the commitment and creativity each artist brings, and we look forward to how your work can contribute to our mission to reveal God's majesty.
